ELIGIBILITY

You may be eligible for SNAP if your pre-tax monthly income is at or below:

Household size	Gross Income
1	\$2,148
2	\$2,904
3	\$3,660
4	\$4,418

+\$758 per each additional member

- Effective October 2021.
- Certain households need to meet a lower Gross Income Guideline.

Additional rules for some, including college students and non-US citizens.

SNAP CANNOT BE USED TO BUY:

Hot or prepared foods
Non food items
Medicine
Vitamins and supplements
Tobacco or alcohol
