Applications are being accepted from the general public for the following position:

Temporary, full-time position. GS level received will be determined by experience, educational credits in the Biological Sciences, and position availability. Employees will work during summer months, mid-May to August/September 2025. Interviews will begin February 24th. Please submit applications before February 24th. After February 24th, please call the number above to inquire about potential vacancies.

<u>OUALIFICATIONS</u>: Applicants for this position must have a high school education. Secondary course work and/or experience in Biological Sciences is preferred but is not required. A valid Driver's License and background check are required.

DUTIES: Duties may include placing and servicing insect traps, collecting insects with nets and by hand, visually surveying for grasshoppers and other pests, and possible application of pesticides for grasshopper suppression activities. Maintaining and submitting accurate records is a must. Data will be gathered with handheld devices and on paper. A majority of the work involves **frequent** extended overnight travel away from Billings/Helena (Mon. - Thurs.) While in official travel status, a government vehicle will be provided, hotel expenses are paid by employer, and meals will be reimbursed. Most of the duties require working independently, without direct supervision, often in rural areas.
