Dates: March 28-30, 2025

Location: White Sulphur Springs, MT

Who can attend: Open to all youth ages 13 and older (as of 10/01/24).

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Registration is completed using Zsuite. Enrolled members and volunteers can access the registration by clicking on "Events" on the left sidebar. The event will only be visible to eligible members.

- \$100 Registration Fee: Incudes meals, lodging (in the school gym), t-shirt and activities.
- Registration is open from February 10 to March 12.

All activities will take place at the school. Female participants and chaperones and male participants and chaperones will be housed in different areas of the school facilities. All participants will need to bring: * Sleeping bag * Air mattress/pad * Pillow * Towel and other personal items. There are locker room bathroom facilities and public style showers.
